Horse Power Healing Center Virtual Show Rules & Guidelines

- 1. Video from "C". Be sure both horse and rider are visible and the appropriate letter for the test movements. Zoom in and out as necessary to view the horse and riders movement. If using a cell phone video in landscape mode.
- 2. Any size arena may be used. Preferred sizes: small arena 20x40m(66'x132') large arena 20x60m (66 'x198')
- 3. Arena letter markers must be visible. (Cones, pails etc. are allowed for markers).
- Create a YouTube video of the test and email the link to info@horsepowerhealingcenter.com Also, include Rider name, horse name and test. You may include multiple video links in one email.
- 5. All riders must wear a helmet.
- 6. Leader and Side walkers are allowed for Therapeutic and Exceptional Equestrian tests.
- 7. Tests may be called by a reader.
- 8. USDF guidelines for appropriate tack. Bitless bridles are permitted.
 Therapeutic, Exceptional Equestrian and Para-Dressage may use modified tack.
 Martingales, horse bandages/boots are not allowed.
- 9. Groundwork horses can be shown in any type of halter. No chains to be used on the halter.
- 10. Lead rope used for Therapeutic or Exceptional Equestrian tests may not be attached to the bit of the bridle.
- 11. Score sheets and ribbons will be mailed after the show. Results will be posted on the HPHC website and Facebook page.
- 12. You may use a video from another show. Videos can be recorded prior to October 2023.

Attire

Helmet is required for all riders. Helmet suggested for groundwork and ground driving tests. Shirt with a collar,(may be short sleeve). Appropriate breeches, pants or jeans. Boots/ shoes with a heel.

Jackets are optional. Chaps are optional.
